### Jaime's Corner

#### *“What Keeps You Going?”*

Rachelle and I were having dinner with friends recently, when one of them asked "what keeps you going? You do so many concerts, and it's got to be so difficult to maintain focus, energy, freshness, not to mention being away from your family and loved ones. Why do you do it?" It is an excellent question that not only my friend Todd asked, but many people ask. So I think it is appropriate to address it in this newsletter.

The weekends of February 20-22 and 27 to March 1 were very frustrating. Unusually cold and wintry weather rendered three of the concerts of those weekends ineffective and nearly useless. I say that because for the handful of people who are either faithful or crazy enough to attend, we went ahead and shared anyway (for them, it wasn't useless). But there are many weekends when, for one reason or another, challenges abound endlessly.

After the third of fourth concerts in one weekend recently, I decided to get a bite to eat at a restaurant before going on to where I would be staying close to the last concert location the following day. When I walked into the restaurant, the entire place was completely full. Even the lounge area with its high tables and chairs was occupied. There was only one seat open at the bar. I sat down and began to guzzle water, as I often get dehydrated during a concert. The couple to my left was a young married couple out on date night. They were very pleasant, and engaged me in conversation once in a while. At one point, we connected on a lengthy discussion about a number of topics.

I learned that the wife is a Christian, and while the husband isn't quite a believer, he is searching. They asked me what I did for a living, and I was happy to share with them my passion and joy for sharing Christ through music and testimony. They asked me some additional and more pointed questions, so I delved into detail the nature of the music I play, and the testimony I share. I told them that I have a burden for inspiring and challenging people to use their talents for God's honor and glory, as well as to help others. I also shared with them that when Rachelle is with me (one or two weekends a month), we like to encourage couples not only to stay married, but also to have a happy and thriving relationship and marriage. At that point I looked at them, and noticed that they were both moved to tears by what I had shared.

It was then that I realized beyond a shadow of a doubt that God had brought me to that place at that moment, to the only open in the entire restaurant, so that the Holy Spirit could use me to bless that young couple. They held hands and told me that I had been used in a special way to encourage them. I told them that I don't believe things happen coincidentally when God is involved!

As soon as I got in the car and began driving to my hotel, I called Rachelle to tell her what had just happened. I was so excited! We both praised God for the opportunity that we all have to be used by Him to reach, touch and bless others. I came away from that meeting feeling as encouraged and blessed as that couple was, if not more! I was reminded that we have a God that isn't just sitting or standing around with His arms crossed as life happens. Our Almighty God is intimately involved in our lives, needs, problems, dreams, etc.

I live for moments and opportunities like this one. There is no greater joy than to serve God. This kind of opportunity is exactly what keeps me going when it comes to concerts and ministry!

As you go about your day this coming week, I invite you to ask God to put people in your path to minister to.
