We were challenged by pastor Julius and Andy to make sure this trip wasn't just a wonderful sensory experience. Our desire was that every person would come back on fire for the Lord, so that we can be living witnesses of God's power, love and grace! And I believe these goals were accomplished!

(I received this text message from a friend on June 10. This is powerful and moving. It's a testament to 1- God's leading in our lives, 2- His perfect plan for all of us and 3- a reminder that God can use anyone willing to be used by Him!)

Hey brother...this is -----.

I just wanted to let you know that last night while driving back from the beach in South Carolina we were about three hours in to our trip and I started having symptoms of something I've only had one time and it was incredibly real...a panic attack. The last time this happened to me was in August 2015 and I thought I would never see the light of day again. Three hours in to it the head of counseling at ----- walked me thru it via breathing and thinking about a song that brought calm and peace to my soul. I just happened to start singing, "peace, peace, wonderful peace." Then I started weeping and shortly thereafter, all was better!

When the same symptoms hit me last night while driving my family home near -----, I opened up the Spotify app on my phone and typed in "peace, peace, wonderful peace." To my shock, the first thing that popped up was your album... it literally floored me. I ended up playing it for the next hour in my earbuds and by the time we made it to ----- I felt like a new person.

Of all the albums and songs that could've popped up I found it unbelievable that yours was first.

God used you in a miraculous way to calm my soul last night which makes me incredibly grateful for you and your ministry.

Thank you brother! Appreciate the thoughtfulness of each song. As a musician I loved it. As a Christian I loved it. As a weary soul I loved it!!!!
