### Jaime's Corner

On behalf of my queen Rachelle, our dedicated and hardworking JJMI/Jealing Music team, Evelyn and Kim, I greet you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, and wish you and your family God's richest blessings!

Before I share with you about my short trip to Cuba last week, I want to ask you to pause and pray with me for our country. Just this week, in Tulsa, OK and Charlotte, NC we have witnessed the loss of life at the hands of law enforcement that has brought about frustration, anger, unrest and destruction. You are probably aware of all this, of course. More than anything, our nation needs Jesus. We also need humility, reconciliation, healing and holiness through Jesus Christ. We are all God's children, no matter the color of our skin. Join me in asking for the Holy Spirit to convict the hearts of the people of the United States, that we would love one another and treat each other as Jesus does! These are indeed difficult times, and there is something we can all do!

Last week I had the opportunity to return to Cuba to continue to support some missionary projects. This was made possible, in part, by the generous support of brothers and sisters in Australia that felt impressed to help further God's work in Cuba. Let us never forget that every single person has the opportunity and privilege to do something for Jesus Christ. God gives us all gifts, talents, blessings, etc., which we can share! Some of the projects being

supported include sponsoring Bible workers/lay missionaries, the purchasing of Bibles and local church ministry.

Back on Dec. 14, 2014, president Obama made a historic announcement that the United States would move towards ending the thaw in relations with Cuba that had been in place since the early 1960's, and re-establishing normal ties. Because the embargo clearly hasn't worked, except to deprive the common people of the most basic of things (read testimonial letter below), I was cautiously optimistic. The next day, the Cuban government, through their mouthpiece newspaper, the *Granma*, made their own announcement. It went something like this: Any foreign company that wants to do business/invest/hire in Cuba is welcome to do so. The Cuban worker will receive 8% of the salary, and the State will receive the other 92% of the salary. So please pray that positive changes will ultimately take place.

Over the last few years, the communist government has gradually lifted sanctions and curtailed their aggression and persecution of Christians and churches. This has resulted in thousands upon thousands of new believers, by God's grace. On many occasions, I have traveled to Cuba (since 2001) to participate in evangelistic efforts, visit home churches, assess projects being sponsored, put on evangelistic concerts, sponsor more projects, and so forth. Because it's not easy to build new (or even remodel) churches, hundreds, if not thousands of home churches, have sprung up throughout the island. I am enclosing 4 pictures of one of these home churches, this one being a rooftop home church.



In addition to "traditional" ways of sharing the gospel, one local church is using soccer (or as the rest of the world calls it, football), to reach neighborhood youth. Even though there are no uniforms, equipment, and

some of the children play without shoes (because they have non), there's quite a bit of participation. They always begin with a devotional and prayer, introducing every young person to Jesus Christ. The young people are taught about Christlike traits- respect, sportsmanship, etc. After the games are over, they come together to worship the Lord. More than 40 young people have given their hearts to Jesus and been baptized through this ministry! Isn't that awesome?!

Their goal is to create a league that will encompass many churches (whose team members are made up of young people in their neighborhoods), so that these youth who may sit around idle, unemployed, bored, frustrated, etc., will join the team and come to know Jesus Christ. I'm already starting to get excited about the possibility of providing some equipment for this team- cleats/tennis shoes, soccer balls, shinguards, perhaps even uniforms (that say on the back of the jersey "Jesus Saves", "God is Love", "Jesus Loves You", etc.).

All of this has brought me a feeling of being human again- waking up in a comfortable pajama, being able to sleep on sheets and make my bed, showering with soap and not just water, and drying myself with a real towel. It's indescribable. Thank you!


