As we grow each year, we will add components to this weekend (speakers, a seminar, and more). At the American School, we found a beautiful campus, a wonderful, dedicated Christian staff, and a precious student population. We were told that 85% of the students are not Christians. The school has an outstanding reputation, and there's a waiting list to get in. So this presents an exciting challenge as well as an opportunity to share with these precious children and young people the love of Jesus!

Every day, Rachelle and I would share carefully-prepared stories, along with the Word of God to the 122 students. Even though we covered the entire 1-8 grades, the students were attentive, engaged and open to the presentations.



After the Week of Prayer presentations, we would go into the classrooms to talk to the students. They asked all kinds of questions, which was fun and challenging. Many of them were hungry and interested in spiritual things. The students were quite impressed when I shared about Rachelle's professional women's football career. She worked with every PE class to go over the fundamentals of playing football.

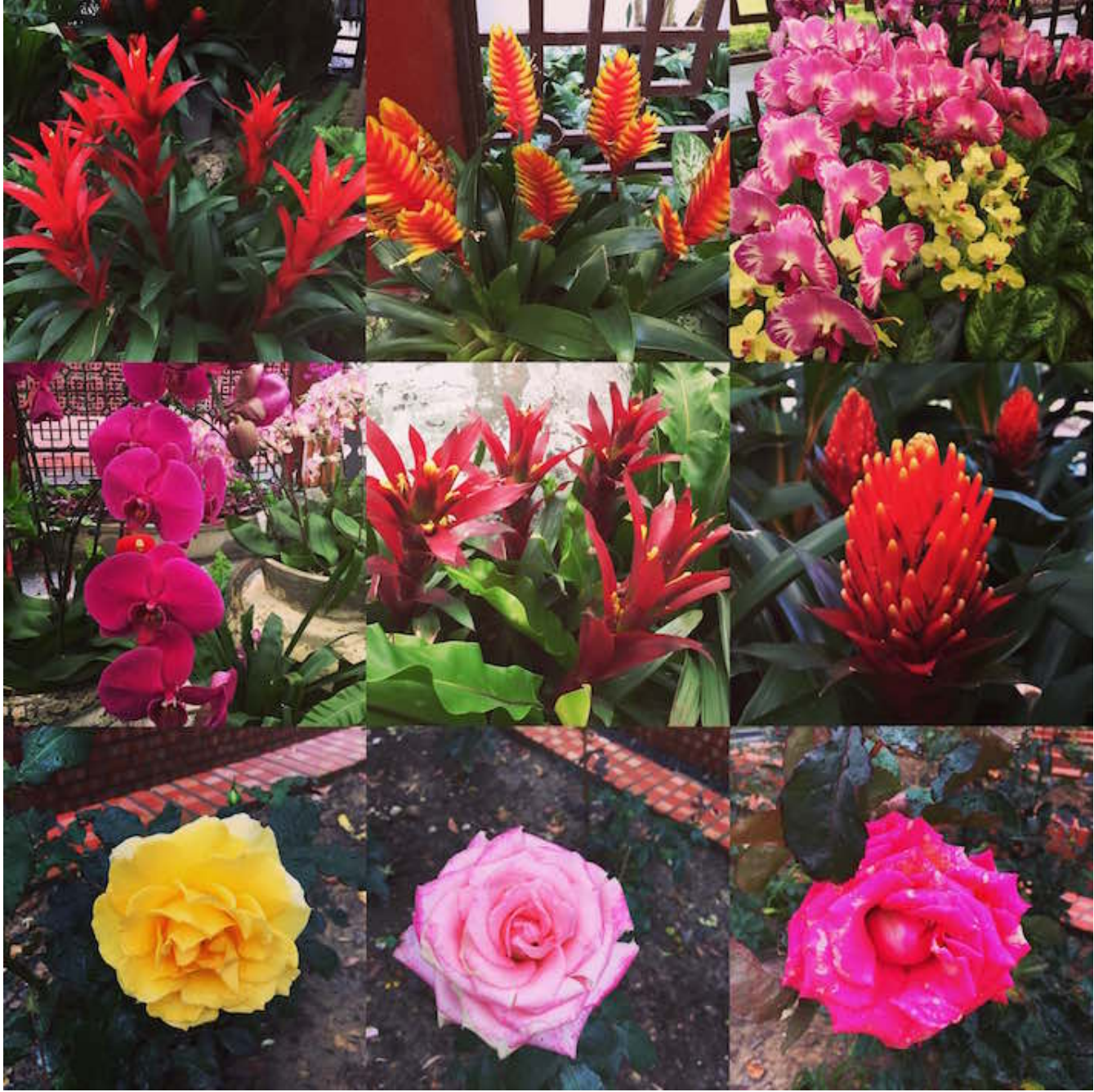

Most of my life has been spent behind a microphone. As a broadcast veteran I've played Jaime's music by radio for more than twenty years. Ten years ago I met Jaime for the first time. The radio station I manage brought Jaime to the region for a few events. I made myself available in case he needed anything during his visit. I don't recall that he did.

He was gracious and kind to me and, by extension, to every person who stepped forward to meet him after each event. This early introduction coupled with ongoing conversation ultimately led to using my skills in Jaime's ministry. Some of what I do includes producing promotional audio and video,

working on print projects, and being one of many to provide behind the scenes support for his 25th anniversary concert. Conducting research is something I do in an effort to access information and knowledge that allows us to do what we've never done before.

I am the husband of one, the father of two, and the grandpa to a very young boy named Elliott (less than a month old at this writing). Over the years I have contributed to more than 100 books. I write and produce audio drama, and am a voice actor and have participated in hundreds of audio drama productions. For several years I was a voice for Fox Sports and worked with the BBC.

Now, before I go on, it feels awkward to talk about accomplishments, but when the praise is reflected back to the God who gave the skill there's a sense that using the skill can mean remembering and honoring the Skill Giver. That's my goal in every project I work on.

Jaime and I touch base from time to time and discuss new ideas and revisit old ones. I suggested Jaime consider a devotional book that blended his life experiences with his love for music. Something tells me his new book won't be the last.

God has gifted each one of us with certain talents. For Jaime it's clearly the violin. For me it seems there is a desire to creatively present ideas, concepts, and dreams. Jaime has shared his ideas with me. My desire is to help him bring those ideas to life. In the end, whatever talents are made available, the common desire is that God be glorified, honored, and made famous through the skillful management of the resources God has given.

It's an honor to work with Jaime, and I pray that God continues to use Jaime's skills to create an atmosphere where God is proclaimed and hearts are drawn closer to His love. This team works together because proclaiming God's love is an understandable language in every culture and for all people.

There are always more people who need to hear that message. If they listen closely they might just hear that message arriving with a violin case and a big heart.

What a witness that was - thank you!

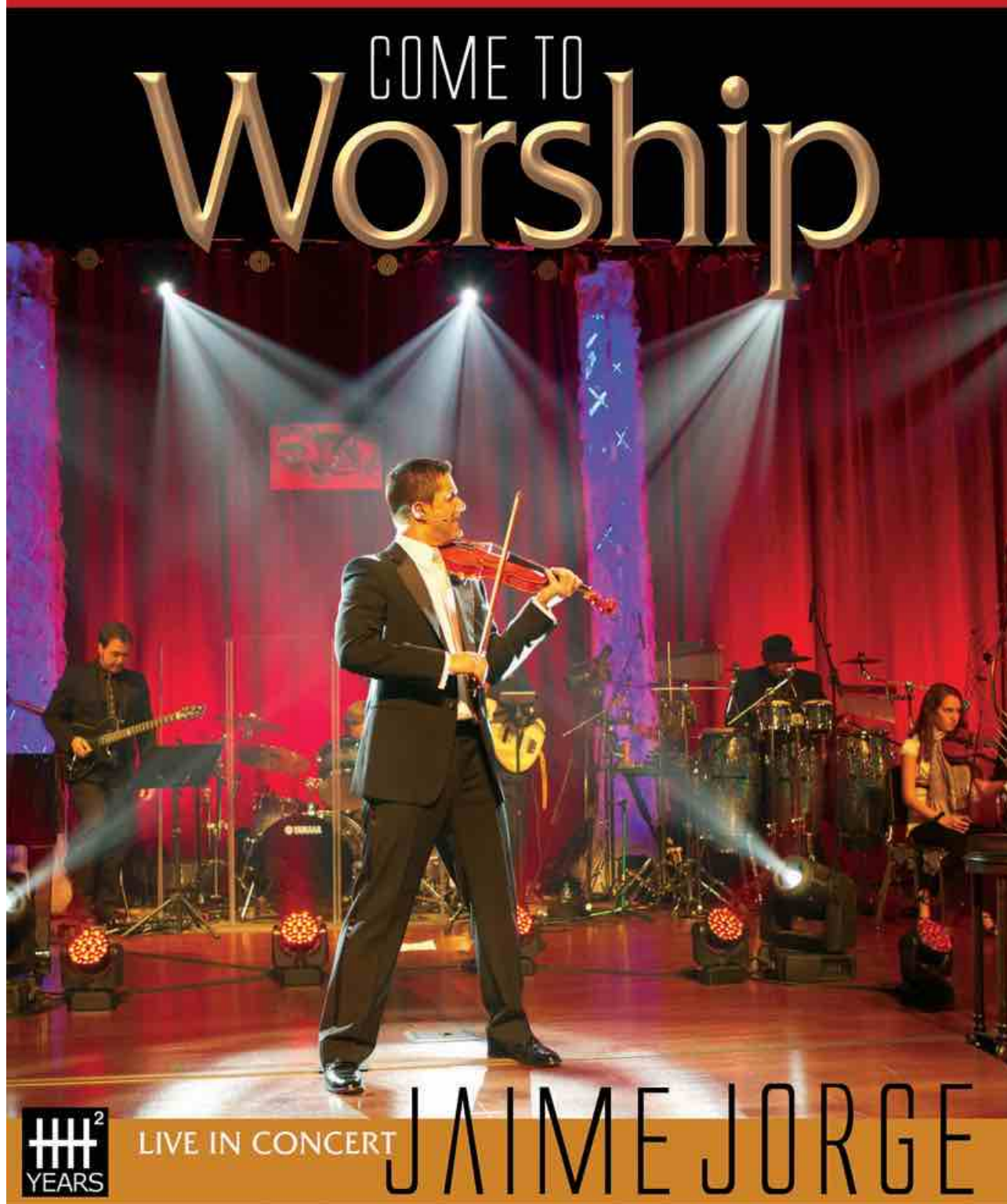

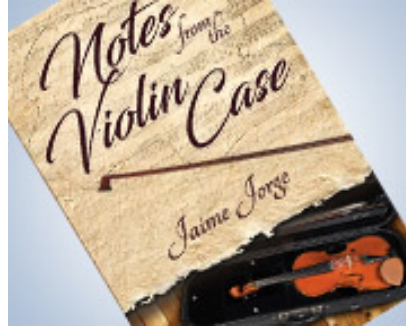

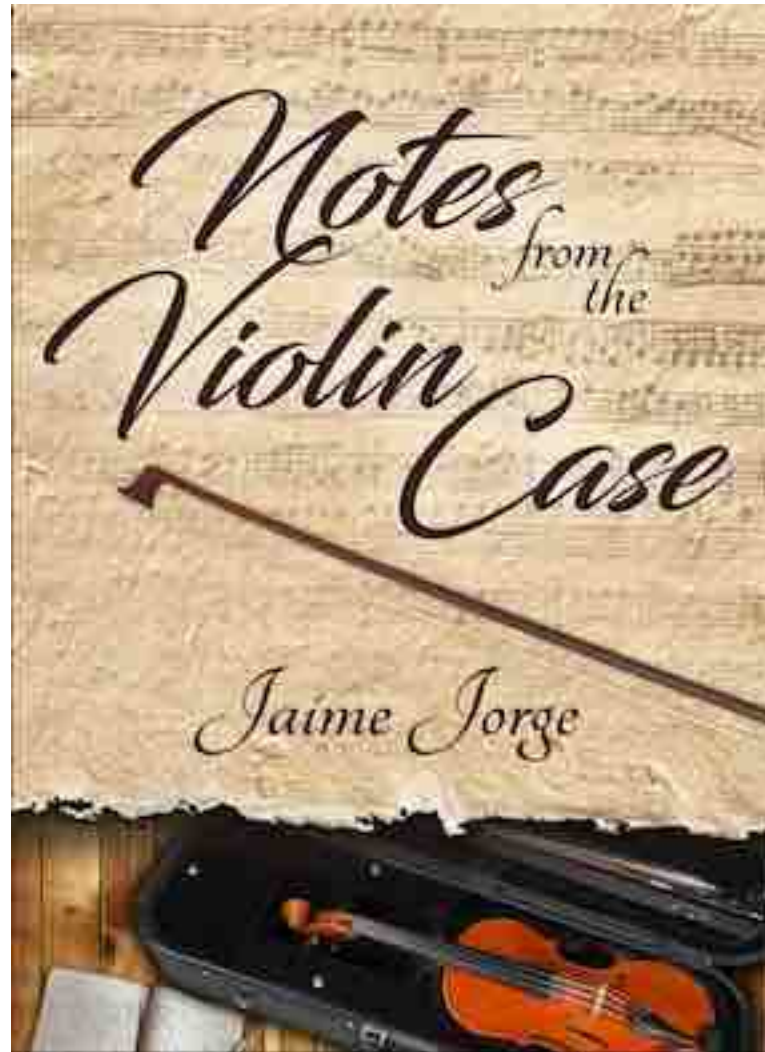
