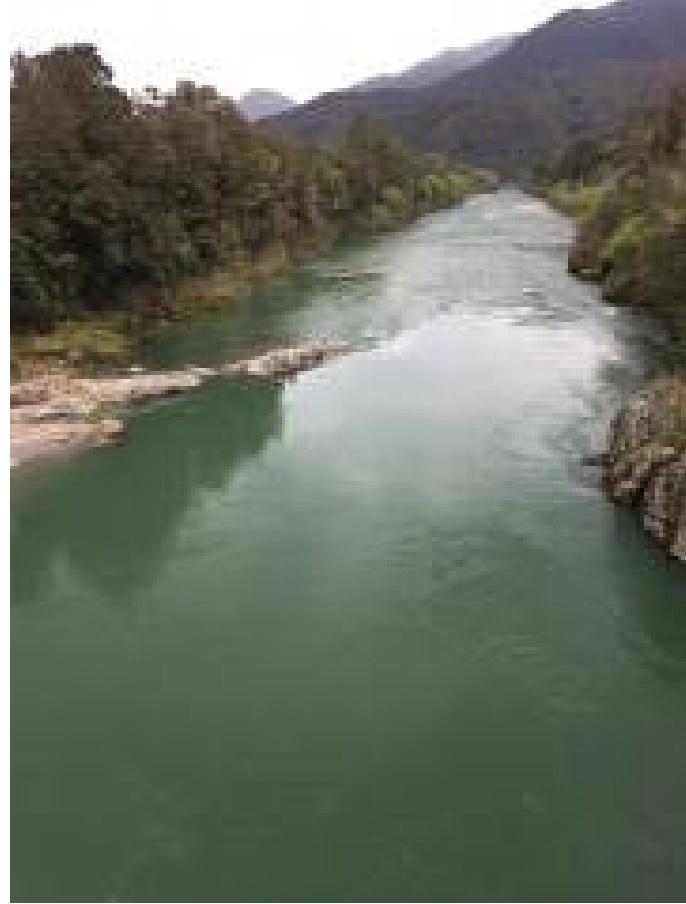

From September to the end of October I had the privilege of doing concerts in 4 countries: New Zealand, Australia, Dubai and England. There was a lot of travel involved, but it was worth the long trips, jet lag, lost bags, and everything else that comes along with travel!

In New Zealand, I had the privilege of doing 8 concerts to raise funds for a Christian TV station that is reaching most of the country! Pastor Paul Hopson, the Assistant to the Manager, and his lovely wife Sarah (pictured about to jump in the pond), were with me the entire time. We traveled throughout both North and South Islands, and in addition to the concerts, we recorded some music videos, as well as did some sightseeing. I have said time and again that New Zealand is the most beautiful country I've ever seen. And this trip did nothing to change my mind. I often wonder what earth looked like when God finished Creation, if there are so many places that can still be so breathtaking beautiful today! This concert happened because of a wonderful lady by the name of Barb, whom I've known for many years. Her husband Graham had a heart for the Lord, along with a passion for mission work and outreach to the people of his country (Australia), and especially for those living in the "outback", as we call it there. Several years ago, Graham sponsored and accompanied me on a tour of 4 weeks going all over the great country of Australia, visiting the small and faraway places that seldom get special programs, concerts, speakers, musicians, etc. The results were amazing as we reached aboriginals, unchurched, simple and wonderful people; all for the glory of God!

The concert and effort in Roma was made possible by Barb, in memory and honor of her beloved husband and my friend Graham. We look forward to seeing Graham in Heaven!



Once back in Brisbane, my good friend and wonderful music minister Sandra Entermann, along with her brother Gary and his daughter, took me on a memorable canoe trip down the river very early Friday morning. Memorable, not only because I flipped over in my canoe not once, but twice; but also because they got up very early, prepared a beautiful breakfast, along with taking care of many other details in order to make this happen, all before Gary flew to Sydney for the weekend!



One of the concerts in Brisbane during the weekend was to help raise funds for a church building. The Lord blessed and over \$15,000 were pledged for this project.

Once in Dubai I had the opportunity to play for Camp Meeting, as well as for St. Luke's Anglican Church for their Harvest Thanksgiving program. It was awesome to worship with nearly 1,000 Christians who came from all over the 7 Emirates of the UAE to praise the Lord and be spiritually fed. On Thursday evening, I received a message on Facebook from a young man by the name of Chisha from Chelmsford, just outside of London. He was lamenting not knowing that I was there, because he had desired to invite me to his church. I told him I wish I would have known because we had 1 slot open- the next night. Within a couple of hours, he had communicated with the church leadership, and it had been agreed by all to extend an invitation to come to do a concert at his church Friday night.

I was coming from the north, and despite the many challenges in getting to Chelmsford- the entire rail system shut down for nearly two hours because of a fatality, having more luggage than I could handle moving around the train system, the shoulder strap on my violin breaking as I tried to pass through the entry gates, and nearly missing the train, the Lord blessed, and I was able to get there.

The Lord knew what He was doing when He worked this out, because there was a group of several young people at the church that play the violin, and I was able to invite them to play a song with me during the concert, as well as encourage them and the rest of the church family. As I was struggling to get

there, I was wondering if I shouldn't have just gone to my hotel to rest and get ready for the rest of the weekend, which was going to be busy enough. But I'm glad I trusted the Lord to work things out, as His plan is always perfect!

After being on the road for 5 weeks, I arrived home exhausted but with a heart filled with joy after seeing how God touched so many lives during this tour. I was also THRILLED to be reunited with my amazing sunshine Rachele, and the newest addition to our family: our puppy Aria :)
