Jaime's Corner

Healing Music team: Kim, Evelyn, Heather, Glenn, Nelson, Janelle, Kristi and Elias, I want to wish you, your family and your loved ones a very Merry CHRISTmas 🎄, and a blessed 2019!

I would like to challenge you to do two things with me the remainder of 2018:

- 1- as we go about all of the activities of this busy season, that we will be focused Jesus Christ, and He will be honored and glorified in all that we do.
- 2- that we daily ask God to put people in our path so that we can share the love, light and joy of Jesus with as many people as possible.

I would like to solicit your prayers on behalf of one of our team members: Kristi. She is our webmaster, and the September 2017 Newsletter Guest Message was written by her. She shared with us a little bit about her, her family and her work. She and her husband Jon have two beautiful children: a five-year-old boy, and a two-year-old girl. Three days ago, she underwent open heart surgery to repair a hole in her heart. We praise the Lord because the operation was a success. I want to let you know that our June 9-18, 2019 pilgrimage to the Holy Land , “**In the Footsteps of Jesus by Word and Song**” is now FULL. There are still a few spots remaining for our spectacular Jordan extension (June 18-21). If you are going with us on this trip and would like to go to Jordan , please let us know right away.

Here is the **GOOD NEWS**: we have decided to add another date and tour- June 2-10. If you are interested in joining us, please contact us immediately so that we can begin the process of organizing everything for you.

If you are interested in the June 9-18 or 21 trip/date, please let us know so we can put you on a wait list in case there are any cancellations.

As you probably know, this is an exciting time of year for me. I have the privilege of putting on 31 concerts, beginning November 27 and before 2018 ends. Since Tuesday, I have been in Wisconsin, South Dakota, North Dakota and Minnesota.

I always look forward to the Christmas tours (for a number of reasons). One such reason is that so many people who don't often or normally attend church come to our Christmas concerts. For instance, Tuesday night, at the start of our tour in Altoona, WI, I was overjoyed to see my friend and college English professor, Mary, attend with her husband Peter. We became friends

in 1988 and have stayed in touch through the years by email and text. I hadn't seen her in over 20 years! We had had many conversations while I was a student in college, about spiritual things. She told me she considers herself and agnostic. After the concert, I spent a couple hours at their home catching up, enjoying a hot drink and some dessert! Please pray that many people will come to Jesus during this season!



Wednesday afternoon I began my 3 1/2 hour drive to the church in Sioux Falls, SD where the concert was to take place. I had been forewarned that some (cold, icy) weather was moving through Sioux Falls and into Minnesota. But I left plenty early in case there were any traffic delays. I was excited to return to South Dakota for the first time in over 15 years.

There were some snow flurries, which made for a beautiful drive and scenery. The salt trucks were out and about, spraying the roads so the moisture wouldn't freeze. But then the temperature dropped over the course of 30 to 45 minutes. Interstate 90 became slick. I prayed and slowed down a little bit. I passed dozens of vehicles and 18 wheelers that had slid off the interstate and/or jackknifed.

Then, exactly 40 miles from the church, I hit a patch of what some call "black" ice. I began to slip and slide. I remembered what I had been taught many years ago during driver's education classes: steer in the direction of the skid. I tried it, but it didn't work. The back of my car looked like a duck racing towards the pond 😊. I drifted to the left and the entire left side of my rented Nissan Rogue hit the cable median. Had I drifted off to the right, there was a pretty steep drop off. I might have wound up there, just like the car about 200 feet in front of me that rolled and ended up about 40 feet from the interstate.

I was able to guide the Nissan back into the freeway (since there were no other vehicles around me at the time of the accident) and it came to a stop on the right shoulder. The first thing I did was praise God.

It was a little smoky and smelly inside the car, because the side airbags had deployed, and one of them had burst. Both tires on the left side of the Nissan were punctured and flat, and the left side of the vehicle looked pretty beat up. But I was not hurt, praise the Lord!

After praying and thanking God for protecting me, I called Pastor Dragos of the Sioux Falls Church and asked him if he could come and get me, because there was still enough time for me to make the concert. Immediately he left the church and headed off to pick me up. That gave me time to call the rental car company and let them know what had just happened, as well as call AAA so a tow truck could pick up the rental vehicle and tow it to the collision shop in Sioux Falls. A state trooper arrived not long after to make sure I was OK, and to fill out a police report. He then put down some flares to warn drivers coming around the curve, since my car had stopped 2 feet from the right lane of the interstate.

Usually, the tow truck takes forever. I was concerned that he would arrive after I left for the church with Pastor Dragos, and he may not be willing to tow the Nissan without me being present. Not only did Phil (the tow truck driver) arrive, but he also arrived 20 minutes early! In fact, he arrived about 10 minutes before Pastor Dragos, who was caught up in a little bit of traffic. Between Pastor Dragos, Phil the tow truck driver and me, we were able to transfer the many boxes and bags (full of CDs, DVDs and other resources for the concerts) into Dragos' Prius, and we took off for the church.

It is all a little bit of a blur after that, but by the grace of God we arrived at the church at 7:07 PM, just seven minutes after the concert was to begin. Also by His grace and with the help of several of the church members, we were able to get everything set up and ready, and I went on stage at 7:20 PM. As I played and shared with the congregation, I thanked God over and over for His mercy, Grace and protection.

The next morning (yesterday), when I called the rental car company at the airport to try to get a new vehicle so that I could head to the next concert, the lady that answered the phone was a church member. She and her husband live outside of town, and the salt trucks and snowplows had not made it to where they lived, so they missed the concert. 😞 When I met her at the airport, she gave me the keys to another rental vehicle, and I gave her one of our Christmas CDs. By the grace of God I was able to get to Bemidji, MN for my concert last night, and I am now on my way to the next concert, and the next, and the next, and the next! I called Phil yesterday to thank him for his help, and he told me that he and his wife had watched some of our presentations on YouTube, and were really blessed!

What a mighty God we serve!

Keep me in your prayers, and I will continue to pray for you and your family!

Until our next newsletter, may “The Lord bless you and keep you; The Lord make his face shine upon you, and be gracious to you; The Lord lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace.” (Num. 6:24-26)

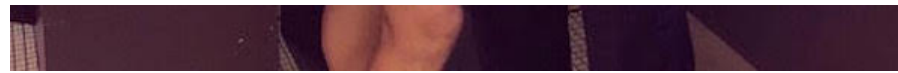

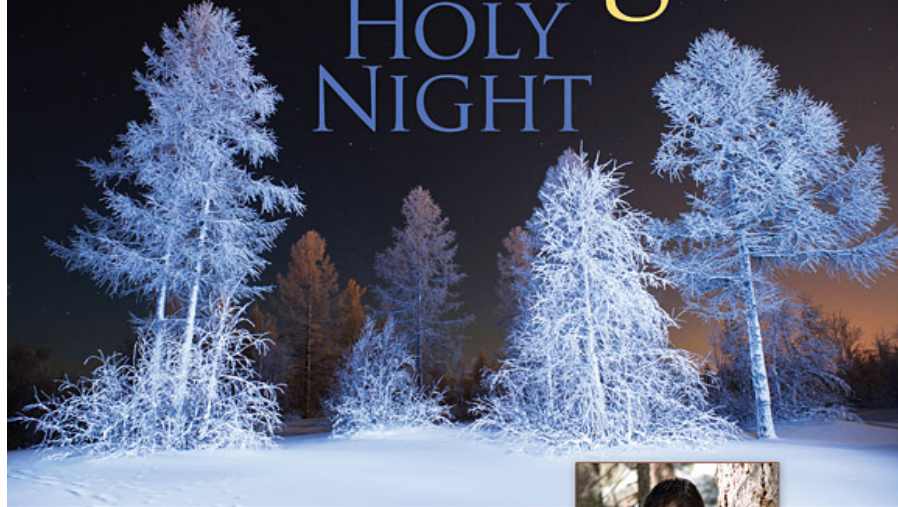

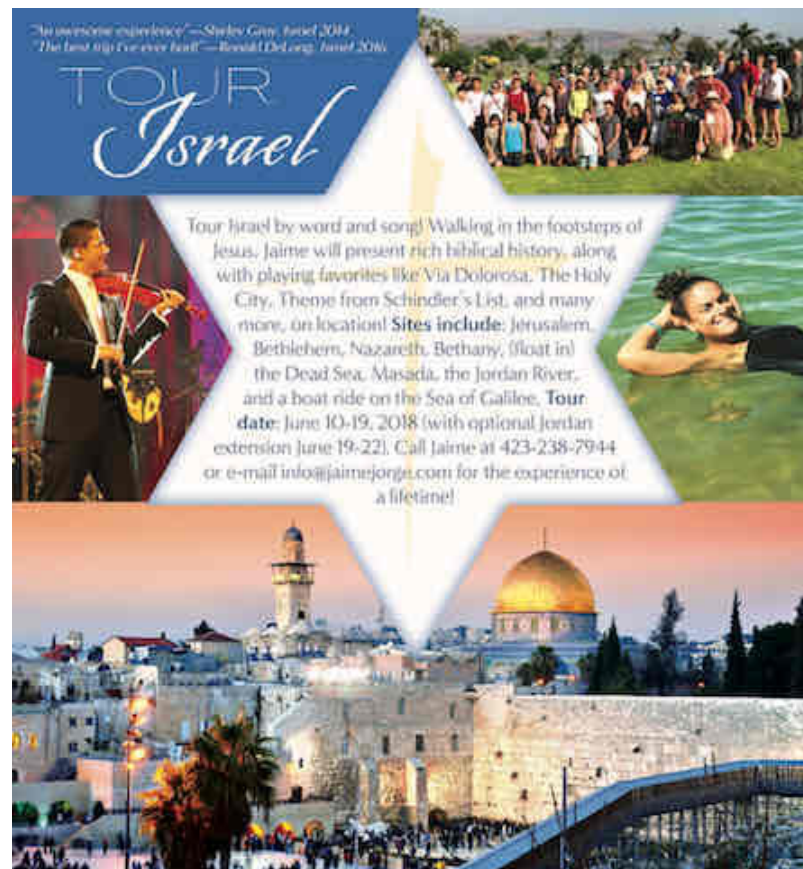
